

## **Registration at Dartmouth High**

In order to register at Dartmouth High School, students must live with a parent or legal guardian in the Dartmouth High area.

To determine whether you live in the Dartmouth High School area and to download a registration form visit [www.hrsb.ns.ca](http://www.hrsb.ns.ca) and select 'Student Registration' from the Quick Links drop-down menu.

Registration of students will take place in Student Services with a guidance counselor:

Ms. Adams (surnames A-K) or Ms. Cameron (surnames L-Z). A parent or legal guardian must accompany the new student **and** be in possession of the following documentation:

- A junior high grade 9 report card or a high school transcript showing marks for all completed courses from previous school (in English).
- Proof of residency such as a current utility bill, lease agreement, etc.
- Proof of your child's date of birth (birth certificate or passport)
- Student's Nova Scotia Health Card number.
- Guardianship information and/or proof of citizenship if required. **Note:** *if student is under 19 and not living with a parent or guardian, an official affidavit appointing legal guardianship must be provided.*
